What is the "Teen LEAD" program?

The Teen LEAD [Leadership, Enrichment and Development] program is a leadership group comprised of dedicated high school students who are interested in making a difference at their library. Teen LEAD members play a critical role in developing the library's young adult collection, building and coordinating teen and tween programs, assisting with children's and teen programs, writing articles, reviews and creative works for the Youth Services Blog, and making the library a friendlier place for young adults.

What are the qualifications?

- Must currently be in grades 9-12.
- Must be willing to commit at least 1 hour, twice a month for meetings.
- Must be willing to assist at children's, tween, and teen programs.
- Must enjoy working in a team environment.

What are the guidelines?

- Meetings occur on Tuesdays (twice a month) from 6-7 PM (unless otherwise stated) and they begin on time.
- Sign in at meetings to record volunteer hours.
- Participate fully; please turn all electronic devices off.
- Respect the staff, each other, and the space.
- Attend meetings and other library sponsored teen events.
- Work with other Teen LEADers to plan and execute teen programs starting in January 2019.

- Your input will have a direct impact on the young adult section of the library.
- Recognition of the value and importance of your opinions and ideas to the community.
